At the start of our meeting we'll be giving everyone a 'gift' - something that most of us haven't had for awhile because we didn't need it... it's guaranteed to build self esteem.

*For Photo and iPhoto a panel of experts will be answering your questions. In anticipation, here are excerpts from an article in Sunday's Herald-Tribune:*

For families that rely entirely on iPhones, there's a major benefit: the ability to share photos among devices almost instantly. Apple phones and computers have **AirDrop**, a tool that transfers pictures directly between devices via a wireless Bluetooth or Wi-Fi connection.

In IOS 11, Apple's latest mobile operating system, you swipe up from the bottom of the screen and hard-press in the upper-left corner to open a hidden Menu that includes AirDrop. From there you can set up AirDrop to receive photos from everyone or just people on your Contacts list.

To share with AirDrop, make sure your relative nearby has AirDrop receiving turned on. On your iPhone, you can select a photo or a group of photos and tap the Share button (a box with an arrow pointing up). Your relative's device will show up under the AirDrop menu, and you can select the device. The files will move over quickly - even a batch of 50 photos will take only a few seconds.

And for those with **AppleTV** - open the photo album on your iPhone and hit the 'share' button, and then tap **AirPlay**. The photos you are looking at on your phone will show up on the Television screen.

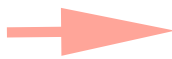

Each time you upgrade your computer or your system the applications may change. Many changes are improvements and they are across the board; by this I mean the same thing happens in Pages or TextEdit or Notes.

If you have a recent computer the change may not be great but if you are like me and are moving from a much older computer as OS 5.8 to OS 10.12.6 then the changes can be significant.



If you get tired of typing you may use **dictation**.

While in Notes or Pages or whatever you're typing on, click on Edit menu at the top and select Start Dictation then a microphone will appear and you can dictating . When you are done you can click on **done** in the little dialog box that shows the microphone.

As with many Apple programs there's another way to get the microphone to appear. Just hit the **clover key twice** which is also called the Apple key or the **command** key, the one next to the spacebar, and a microphone will appear.



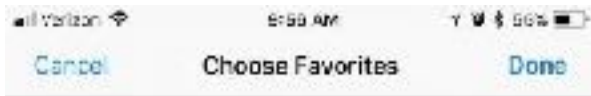
***What** if you just tried something that you read about in this newsletter and the link doesn't work on your computer? Well sometimes a different version works fine but your version may not. I just discovered using this new computer that one of the links I used and tried out on my old computer in last months newsletter no longer works with Safari on the new computer: it works fine with Firefox the difference is the website had set up a blocker that insisted you buy a pass to view it using Safari but it had **NOT** figured out how to do that yet in Firefox . (on my old computer Safari works fine so it's hard to say exactly why something doesn't work .but give it a try you can't hurt much and if it doesn't work they're always workarounds like substituting browsers.*

**Did you Know** that one of the most versatile programs on your Mac is named Preview. That is a good name. If you click on a file it will usually open Preview to give you a sneak peek view the file is without double-clicking. So in effect it previews the file which can be a PDF text file or a JPEG or a variety of other picture type files. Of course if you double-click that particular file will open fully in Preview.

## How to View Burst Photos on iPhone

Taking an iPhone **burst photo** is a great way to guarantee you get the action shot you want. If you stumble across a once-in-a-lifetime shot and want to be certain you have plenty of images to choose from, Burst Mode on iPhone is the way to do it. But when you take a photo in Burst Mode on iPhone, all the pictures are shown together as one photo in the Photos app. This leaves a lot of people wondering how to view burst photos then save their favorite individual burst photos. What is Burst Mode on iPhone? It's a sequence of photos taken quickly one after the other **by holding your finger on the iPhone's shutter button**. There's no need to turn iPhone Burst Mode on like other iPhone camera functions. Burst Mode is always ready, allowing you to capture action shots at a moment's notice. We'll cover how to view burst photos as well as how to save the iPhone burst photos you want to keep.

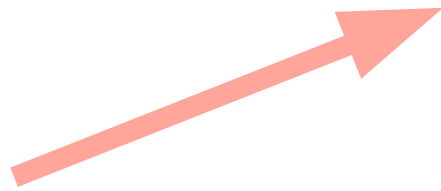
Anyway when I was done I thought how do I get this off this computer. I mean I don't want my Facebook account which anybody can modify on this computer if it's used by somebody else.

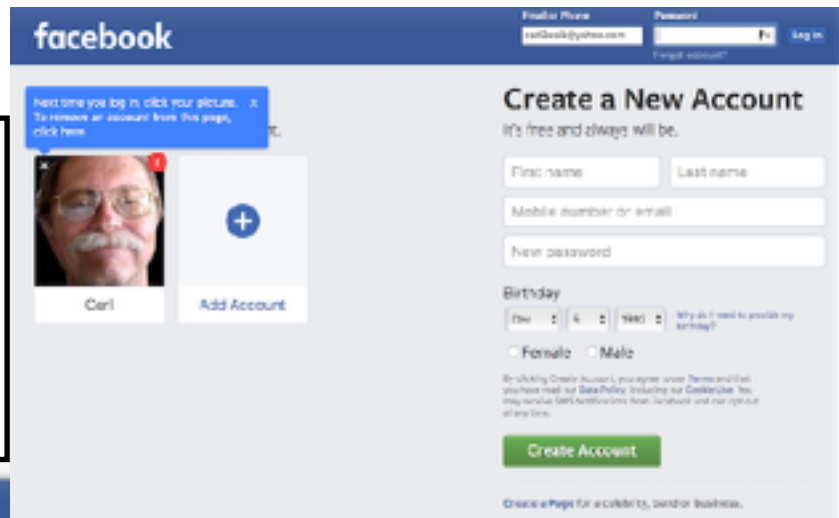
To log out of Facebook on another computer, phone or tablet:

1. Go to your **Security and Login Settings**
2. Click **Where You're Logged In**
3. Find the session you want to end and click **End Activity**

Clicking **End Activity** will immediately log you out of Facebook on that device.
