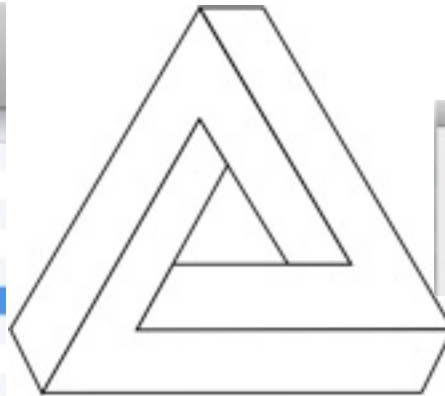
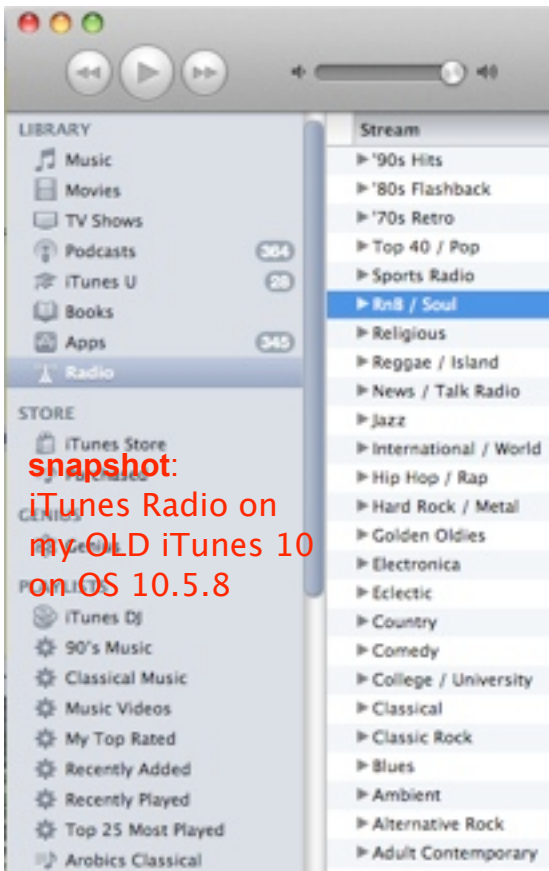
Checkout period is for one month or till the next meeting. All books will be available at the meeting. There are also *MacLife* magazines from 2012 and 2013.

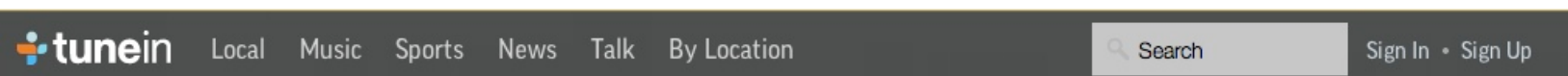

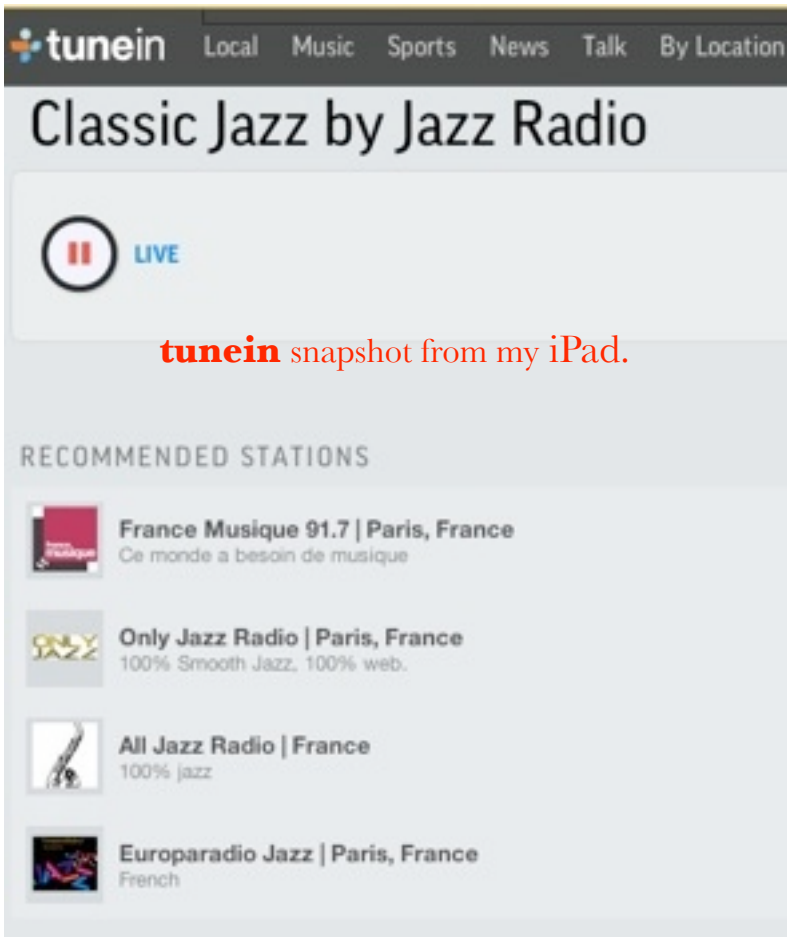

**tunein** is also available on your computer browser as a website. Works great!

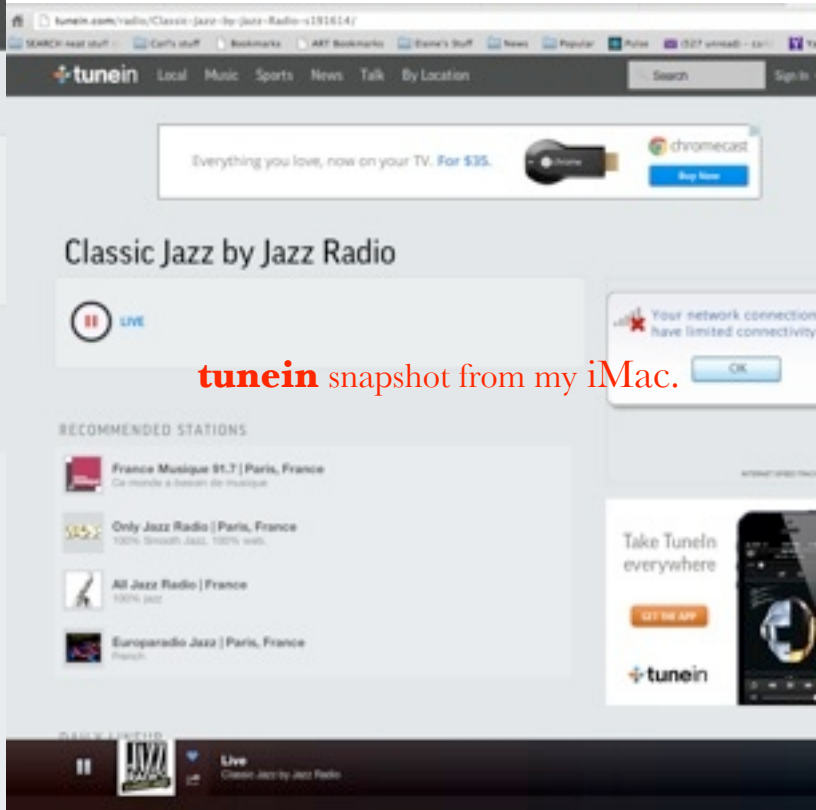

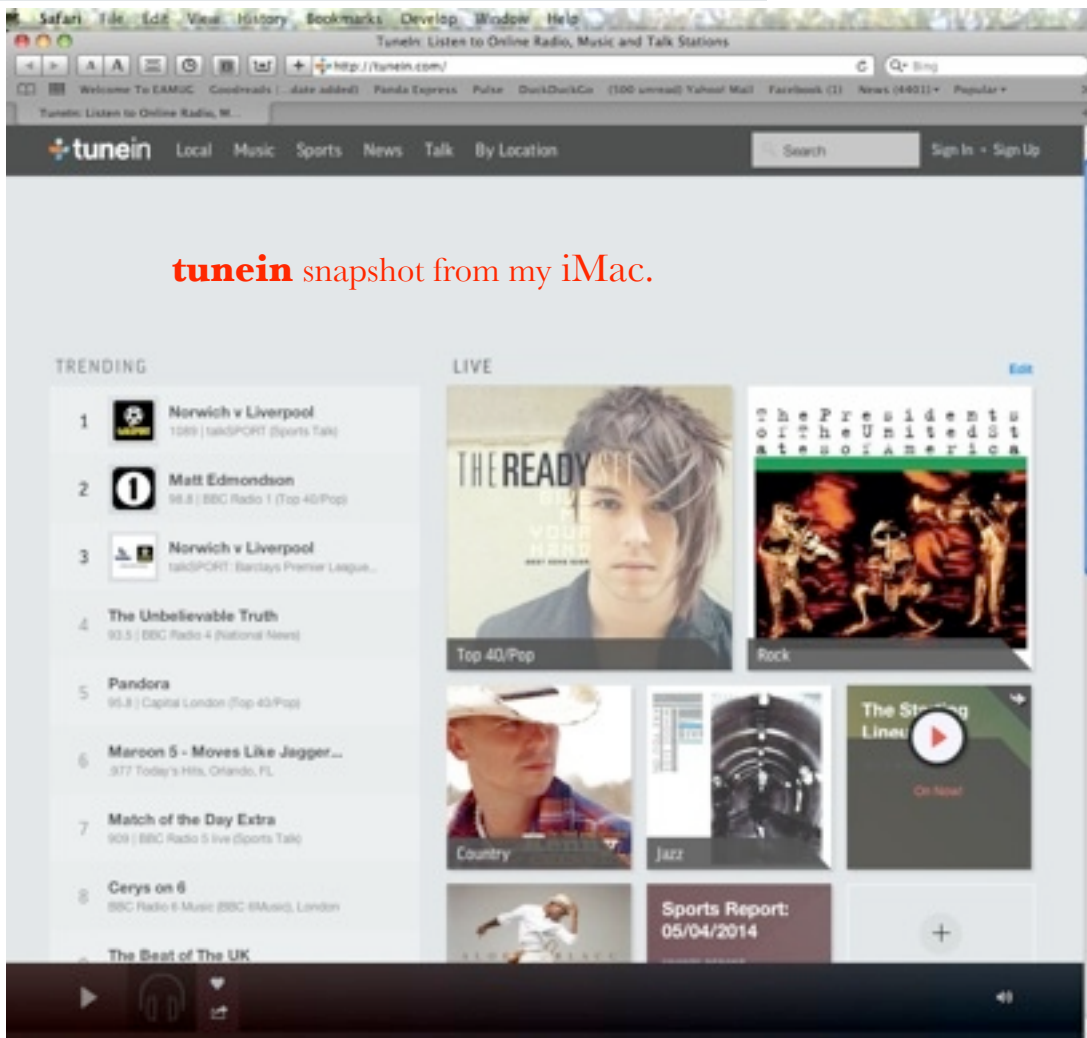

Both Services work great.

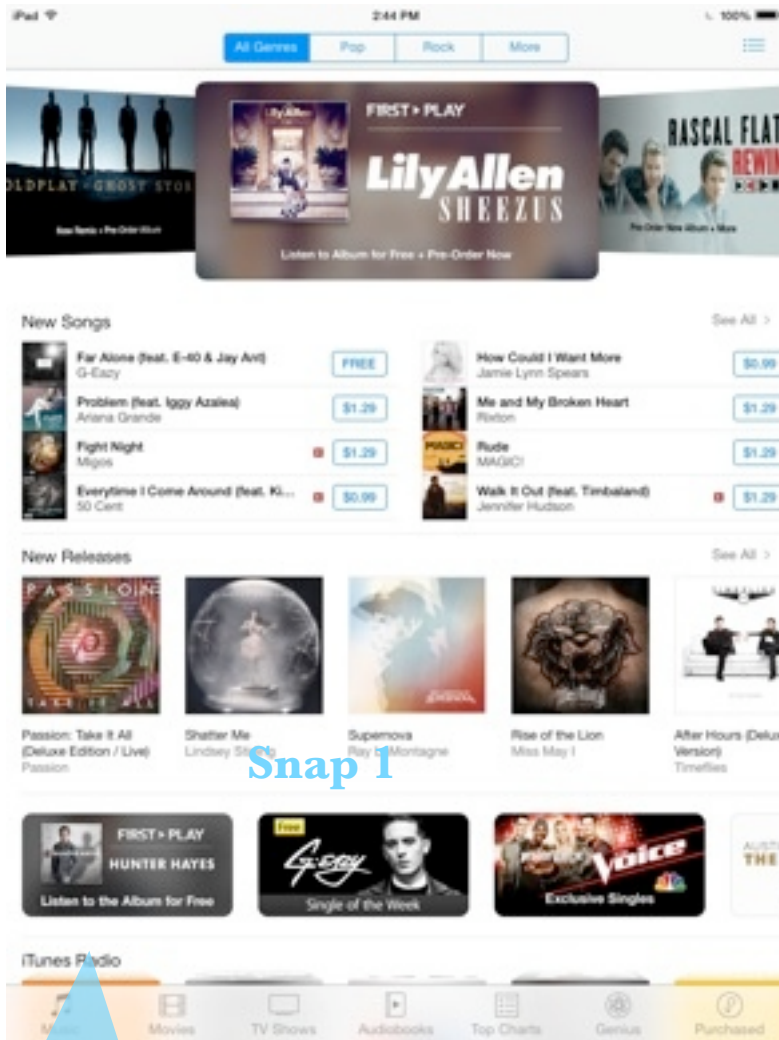
Be sure to use good headphones as the iPad and iPods speakers are not hi fi.

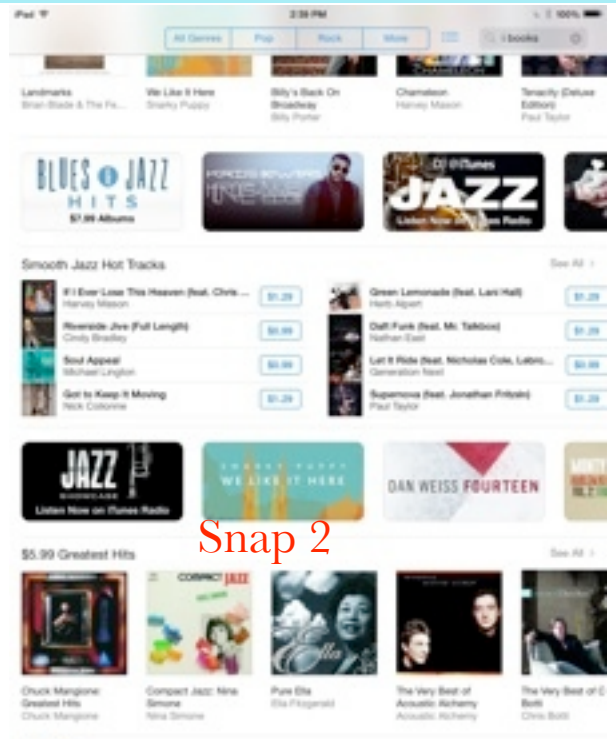

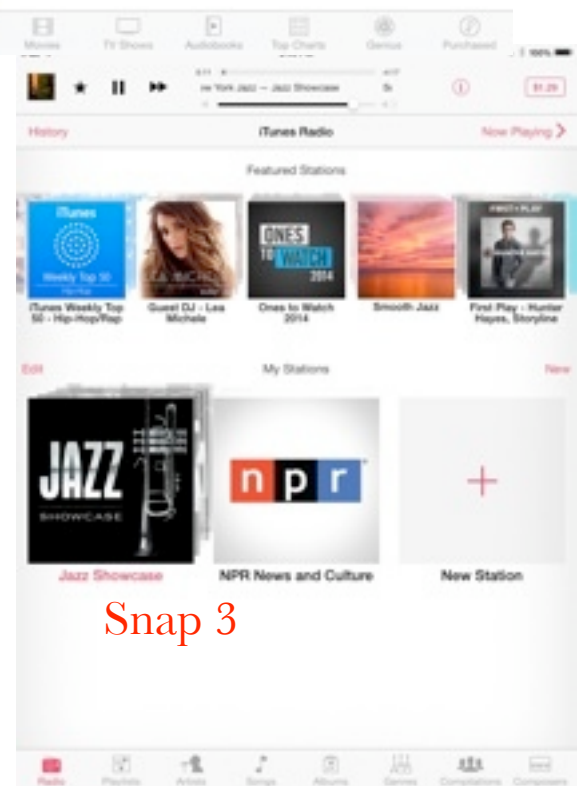
Apple Radio snapshots from my iPad and iPod.

- \*I. On my old System I get a message that Chrome can't use Adobe Flash Player, but do I want to play it this time anyway. I click yes and it works. Thank you Chrome.
2. Since you are connecting to a streaming radio station sometimes the station may be off the air. Choose another.
3. tunein even works on my old ipod touch (2008 with IOS 4) Even though you get a warning when it downloaded it gave me an option to change to a version that works. Thanks to good programming on tunein!
